SPECIFICATION FOR POULTRY FEEDS

1 SCOPE

This Mauritian Standard specifies the basic requirements for poultry (layer, broiler and breeder) feeds.

2 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this standard the following definitions apply.

- 2.1 *Product unit*: One unit of the final product consisting of the sealed package.
- 2.2 *Lot*: Collection of product units of the same size, type and style which have been manufactured, processed or packaged under essentially the same conditions.
- 2.3 *Compound feedstuff*: A product obtained by mixing two or more raw materials.

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
