

## Casual shoes – Specifications

### 1 Scope

This Mauritian Standard specifies requirements for casual shoes manufactured by different processes.

This standard is applicable to general casual shoes whose upper is made of natural leather, artificial leather, synthetic leather, textiles and multiple materials.

This standard is applicable for casual shoes with footwear size as from (French 21)(English 3).
