SPECIFICATION FOR COTTON EMBROIDERY THREADS

1 SCOPE

This Mauritian Standard deals with the constructional details and other properties of 100% cotton embroidery threads, unbleached, bleached or dyed. However, it does not specify the type of finish or the degree of whiteness of the bleached embroidery threads or the colour of the dyed embroidery threads.

2 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this standard the following definitions apply.

2.1 *Lot*: collection of product units of the same type and style which have been manufactured under essentially the same conditions.

2.2 *Specimen*: A unit which is subjected to a test.

2.3 *Package*: A tube, cone, reel, ball or skein.
