SPECIFICATION FOR MEN'S DRESS SHIRTS

1 SCOPE

This Mauritian Standard applies to dress shirts made from woven fabrics. It also deals with the marking, measurements and labelling of the shirts. It does not, however, specify the shade, appearance, feel or the constructional particulars of the fabrics used.

2 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this standard the following definitions apply.

- 2.1 *Lot*: Collection of product units of the same type and style which have been manufactured under essentially the same conditions.
- 2.2 *Specimen*: A unit which is subjected to a test.
- 2.3 *Collar size*: The measurement from centre of buttons to end of button holes.
- 2.4 *Suitable*: Suitable to the purchaser but in relation to the certification mark suitable to the Mauritius Standards Bureau.

3 REQUIREMENTS
