

Specification for toilet paper

1 Scope

This Mauritian Standard specifies the requirements for three grades of creped or creped and embossed toilet paper supplied in rolls.

3 Terms and definitions

For the purpose of this standard the following definitions apply.

3.1

cross-direction (CD)

the direction of a paper at right angles to the machine direction.

3.2

machine direction (MD)

the direction of a paper corresponding to the direction of flow of the stock on the paper machine.

3.3

sheet

the portion of toilet paper between consecutive rows of perforations on a roll irrespective of whether the toilet paper is single-ply or double-ply.
