## SPECIFICATION FOR PVC RAINCOATS

### 1 SCOPE

This Mauritian Standard specifies minimum requirements for unsupported polyvinyl chloride raincoats.

### 2 DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this standard the following definitions apply:

2.1 *Acceptable*: Acceptable to the purchaser

2.2 *Batch*: A collection of raincoats of the same type, grade, size and colour manufactured under conditions which are presumed to be uniform.

2.3 *Defect*: Any non conformance of a raincoat to the requirements specified in 4.1.
