SPECIFICATION FOR SANITARY TOWELS

1 SCOPE

This Mauritian Standard specifies the manufacturing and performance requirements for sanitary towels for external use.

2 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this standard the following definitions apply.

2.1 *Lot*: A number of product units of the same size, type and style which have been manufactured under essentially the same conditions.

2.2 *Extraneous dust*: Atmospheric particulate matter that is produced from a source or sources other than the components used in the manufacture of sanitary towels.

2.3 *Mechanical pulp*: Papermaking pulp made entirely by mechanical means from various raw materials but usually from wood.
