

1 Scope

This Mauritian Standard establishes the materials, design and make of the three types of the National Flag* of the Republic of Mauritius.

The three types of the National Flag are as follows:

- a) Mast Flag
- b) Desk Flag/ Hand held Flag
- c) Car Flag

* 'National Flag' is referred to as 'The Flag' throughout the document.
