

Technical standard for limited payout machine

1 Scope

This standard specifies the general hardware and software requirements and the list of significant events for gaming equipment to be used in premises licensed to operate for limited payout machines. This equipment will be attached to a central electronic monitoring system (CEMS) as from the date as may be notified in writing by the Authority. The central electronic monitoring system (CEMS) implemented has to be compatible with existing limited payout machines.

The list of games to be played on limited payout machine shall be approved by the Authority.
