

## **The National Flag - Part 3: Colour codes on paper**

**IMPORTANT — The colours represented in Annex A can be neither viewed on screen nor printed as true representations. It is not intended that these printed copies be used for colour matching.**

### **1 Scope**

This Mauritian Standard establishes the colours of the National Flag of the Republic of Mauritius on paper.

### **3 Terms and definitions**

For the purposes of this standard, the following terms and definitions apply:

#### **3.1**

##### **acceptable**

acceptable to the authority administering this standard, or to the parties concluding the purchase contract, as relevant.

### **4 The National Flag on paper**

#### **4.1 Description**

The height shall be divided in four equal horizontal bands, with colours, named red, blue, yellow and green respectively and the print shall be clear. (see Annex A Figure 1)

#### **4.2 Colour standards/references for the flag on paper**

The colour standards/ references (colour codes) of the four colours of the National Flag on paper shall be as specified in Table 1.
